



SBA Disaster Loans & Grants Information

Emergency Economic Injury Disaster Loans and Grants Program. APPLY DIRECTLY TO SBA. You or your organization could be eligible for an IMMEDIATE GRANT of up to \$10,000. **NOTE: THIS IS SEPARATE FROM THE SBA PAYROLL PROTECTION PROGRAM LOAN. THE SBA'S DISASTER LOANS AND GRANTS ARE AVAILABLE NOW.**

The following are eligible for this program:

- Businesses with 500 or fewer employees
- Individuals who operate under a sole proprietorship or as an independent contractor
- Cooperatives and employee owned businesses
- Private non-profit organizations or faith-based organizations

To access these funds, you must first apply for an SBA Disaster Loan, and then request the advance. The advance does not need to be repaid under any circumstances.

Gather the following information before you begin the process:

- Tax ID or Employer ID Number (if you are a sole proprietor, you can use your SSN)
- Gross Revenues for 12 months prior to 1/31/2020
- Cost of Goods Sold for 12 months prior to 1/31/2020
- If your organization is a non-profit
 - Cost of operation for 12 months prior to 1/31/2020
- If your organization is a church
 - Cost of operation for 12 months prior to 1/31/2020
 - Combined expenses for all Secular Social Services provided
 - List of Secular Social Services provided (such as childcare, feeding programs, financial assistance, etc.)
- Date your business or organization was established
- Bank Account Number & Bank Routing Number

Here's how to apply:

2. Complete the simple, three screen application form online.
3. **IMPORTANT! On the third screen, MAKE SURE TO CHECK THE BOX THAT SAYS "I WOULD LIKE TO BE CONSIDERED FOR AN ADVANCE OF UP TO \$10,000."**
